2004 ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET (MAJOR CHANGES FROM 6/30/2004 – 12/31/2004)

- Arizona – The State Medicaid Enrollment increase was due to a large uninsured population that is potentially eligible for Medicaid in any given month and the legislatively mandated change in re-determination for eligibility to 12 months was implemented in August 2004.
- Washington – The State Medicaid Enrollment decrease was due to the deployment of military personnel. WA has a large number of military families receiving medical assistance.
- West Virginia – The Managed Care Enrollment is an estimate number as the State cannot provide an accurate number due to the MMIS conversion.
