On March 31, 2003, Bill Schultz, Esq. (outside counsel for the National Center for Tobacco-Free Kids et al.) called Michael M. Landa, Esq. and myself regarding the above-referenced citizen petitions seeking regulation of Ariva. He reiterated petitioners' position that Ariva should be regulated as a food or a drug under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as well as their belief that the Supreme Court's decision in Brown & Williamson does not bar FDA jurisdiction over this product. He also stated that if the agency declined to regulate Ariva, it would discourage drug companies from developing smoking cessation products.
