Dear Dr. Estrup:

The Office for Human Research Protections (OHRP) has received your October 9, 2001 response to concerns regarding Brown University's (Brown) corrective actions for non-compliance in research involving prisoners as subjects. Based on this response, OHRP makes the following observations:

- (1) OHRP acknowledges that the "High-Risk Behaviors" study was completed in 1997, several years before OHRP made its determinations.
- (2) OHRP acknowledges that the "Learning Disabilities" study is ongoing but no longer includes the participation of prisoner subjects and therefore does not need to be certified

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to the Secretary of Health and Human Services. In addition, although the grant application was never reviewed by the Institutional Review Board (IRB), the grant for this project expired over a year ago. However, OHRP acknowledges the Brown IRB's plans to review the expired grant at the next continuing review of the project, in February of 2002.

Based upon this information, OHRP has determined that Brown's implementation of corrective actions is adequate. OHRP anticipates no further OHRP involvement in this matter.
