Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 403(r)(6) (21 U.S.C. § 343(r)(6)) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act that Met-Rx USA, Inc. <u>Protein Plus Soy:</u> Heart healthy. Glutamine is the most abundant amino acid in plasma and muscle. It serves an important role in your immune system and muscle metabolism. Based on current scientific knowledge, you should consume 0.68-0.91 grams of protein per pound of body weight per day. This is an optimum amount for those interested in building muscle and improving recuperation after a hard, intense exercise bout.
