

This nonthermogenic beverage is ideal as a pre-workout, workout and post-workout nutrition supplement because it contains 68 grams of muscle-feeding carbohydrates...for muscle hydration and...to support blood glucose levels. Carbo Rush will support a fast and sustained energy rush for a more intense, more powerful workout session.
