Odorless Garlic: [For] healthy heart. [It] helps maintain healthy cardiovascular and circulatory function. Each caplet provides 600 mg of garlic supplying 6 mg of allicin yield, which is equivalent to one fresh garlic clove. Allicin is the active ingredient in garlic that scientists believe is responsible for providing cardiovascular benefits and it is an important measure of garlic's potency and benefits.
