SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES

This letter is to inform you of an additional communication tool to be used for issuing information to the directors of the local child support agencies. The Local Child Support Agency (LCSA) Letter will now replace the previous IV-D Directors letter. Future communications will be sequentially numbered, beginning with this first letter. In the past, IV-D Directors letters were not numbered, making it difficult to catalogue. In the future the LCSA Letters will also be available on a county accessible website.

The LCSA Letter will be used to disseminate information pertinent to the daily operations of each local child support agency. It will be distributed to the District Attorney and/or Director of the LCSA of the County. Policy changes, new policy, or other information regarding the Child Support Program will continue to be issued via the Child Support Services (CSS) Letters.

We recognize communication plays a key role in the administration of the Child Support Program, and we are committed to working with you to ensure we utilize the most effective means of sharing information.
