SUBJECT: ANNUAL AUTOMATION COOPERATION AGREEMENT (ACA)

This letter is to inform you that your current ACA will be amended to extend the effective date to June 30, 2002. The passage of Senate Bill (SB) 943 removed the December 1 effective date that was in Welfare and Institutions Code (W&IC) section 10084(b). Additionally the ACA will be incorporated into the Department's Plan of Cooperation.

Attached is an amendment page to the ACA similar to the one used when a county transitioned out of the Office of the District Attorney. The amendment page will require the signature and date of the District Attorney or the Local Child Support Agency Director whichever is applicable. **The amendment needs to be signed and returned to the Department by December 1, 2001 as the effective date of the current ACA expires November 30, 2001.** Send the ACA amendment to Department of Child Support Services, P. **AMENDMENT _____ TO THE
ANNUAL AUTOMATION COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This Amendment ____ to the Annual Automation Cooperation Agreement (AACA) dated December 1, 2000, is made by and between the California Department of Child Support Services (the Department) and the _____ County Department of Child Support Services (the County), is effective November 30, 2001:

I. RECITALS

- A. California Welfare and Institutions Code §10084(b) requires that the DCSS enter into an AACA with each County Department of Child Support Services.
- B. The AACA dated December 1, 2000 by and between DCSS and the County expires by its own terms on November 30, 2001.
- C. DCSS and the County desire by this Amendment to extend the effective date of the AACA dated December 1, 2000.

II. AGREEMENT

- 1. The effective date of this AACA is December 1, 2000 through June 30, 2002.
- 2. All references in the AACA and any Exhibits or other Amendments to the term of the AACA shall now read December 1, 2000 through June 30, 2002 instead of December 1, 2000 through November 30, 2001.
- 3. All other terms and conditions in the AACA, Exhibits and Amendments shall remain the same.
