SUBJECT: ANNUAL AUTOMATION COOPERATION AGREEMENT (AACA)

This letter is to inform you that your current AACA will be amended to extend the effective date to December 31, 2002. The passage of Senate Bill (SB) 943 removed the December 1 effective date that was in Welfare and Institutions Code (W&IC) section 10084(b). Additionally the AACA will be incorporated into the Department's Plan of Cooperation to make both effective dates the same. The current Plan of Cooperation expires December 31, 2002. Therefore, the AACA is being extended to expire on the same date.

AMENDMENT <u>2</u> TO THE ANNUAL AUTOMATION COOPERATION AGREEMENT DATED DECEMBER 1, 2000 BETWEEN CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES AND _____COUNTY CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES AGENCY
