SUBJECT: SSN REMOVAL FROM TREASURY CHECKS

The purpose of this letter is to provide local child support agencies (LCSAs) with additional information on the removal of the Social Security Number (SSN) from treasury checks. The Department of Treasury's Financial Management Service (FMS) has agreed to keep the SSN on child support treasury checks until December 1, 2004.

For a majority of the child support payments, the SSN will no longer appear in its customary location in the Payee Identification line at the top of the check. Starting in January 2004, the SSN will be in the Payment Identification line, near the bottom of the check. The child support Treasury checks from the Social Security Administration (SSA) will continue to have the SSN at the top of the check, due to processing methods unique to SSA.
