SUBJECT: US AIRWAYS BANKRUPTCY FILING – CANCELLED CHECKS

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) has been notified by US Airways of their recent Bankruptcy Chapter 11 protection filed on September 12, 2004, (Case No. 04-13819). As a result, a stop payment was placed on all child support checks that had not yet cleared US Airways' bank.

US Airways has informed DCSS that child support replacement checks have been issued since September 3, 2004, as obligations were withheld from their employees' earnings. These checks are valid and will be honored by US Airways' bank. US Airways has requested that we process these checks as usual to ensure a smooth operation on behalf of thousands of beneficiaries, especially those who rely on child support to sustain their families.
