SUBJECT: THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES INFORMATION SECURITY MANUAL COMPLIANCE PACKAGE

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) Information Security Office (ISO) has developed an Information Security Manual (ISM) compliance package to assist each applicable organization to record their current compliance status. All applicable organizations are required to certify compliance with the ISM by submitting the Compliance Certification, DCSS ISM Form 1310, by October 31 of each year, beginning this year, as stated in CSS Letter 07-01.

This compliance package contains instructions to complete the compliance process, a high-level matrix and a detailed checklist to provide step by step guidance for ISM compliance. The high-level matrix and checklist can be used to track and measure the security posture of your organization. The certification process requires all applicable organizations that are not fully compliant with the ISM to file a mandatory exception request for all areas of noncompliance. The ISM is available on the LCSA Secure Website and the exception request process is detailed in DCSS ISM 1200 Exception Handling Procedure.

Only the Annual ISM Certification Form and exception requests are required to be submitted to the DCSS Information Security Office by October 31, 2007. The completed checklist and Matrix are not required to be submitted to DCSS.
