SUBJECT: CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT (CSE) 1257 BACK UP DATA (CBUD)

As Local Child Support Agencies (LCSAs) transition into California Child Support Automated System (CCSAS) Child Support Enforcement (CSE) system, the Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) identified the need to develop a tool that will give LCSAs access to the monthly and annual case and participant level detail that supports the CS 1257 and Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) 157 Performance Reports. Change Request (CR)-2-01171 was approved in April 2007 to meet the business need of providing backup data for the performance reports. The purpose of CR-2-01171 is to provide a tool outside of CSE that will allow DCSS, LCSAs, and auditors to view the backup data reported on the CS 1257 and OCSE 157 reports for each transitioned county.

The web based tool that has been created for this purpose is named: CSE Back Up Data or CBUD. The CBUD application was released into production in October 2007, and it is located in the LCSA secure web site. The URL for LCSAs to access the site is https://counties.dcss.ca.gov/main/logon.asp.
