2	CHAIR SMEGAL: This is a meeting of the annual
3	performance review committee, and we are gathered at 5:00,
4	Central Standard Time.
5	MOTION
6	CHAIR SMEGAL: And I would entertain a motion to
7	approve the agenda, which is found at page 75 of the board
8	book.
9	MS. MERCADO: So moved.
10	MR. EAKELEY: Second.
11	CHAIR SMEGAL: As many as are in favor, please say
12	aye.
13	(Chorus of ayes.)
14	CHAIR SMEGAL: I would note the presence at the
15	moment of board members Bill McCalpin and LaVeeda Battle, and
16	Ernestine and Nancy, and John and Doug, in addition to those
17	who made motions and seconded. And on the phone is Bucky
18	Askew. I believe that accounts for everyone, with the
19	exception of John Broderick and Ernestine I'm sorry, Edna.
20	Ernestine is here. Edna is going to come back. We also
21	have our president with us, and Mattie is out there in the
22	audience at the moment.

1	MOTION
2	CHAIR SMEGAL: All right, we've approved the
3	agenda, we have some minutes of a prior meeting of this
4	committee on November 10, and I would entertain a motion to
5	approve those minutes; they are found at pages 76, 77, and
б	78. Is there such a motion? Oh, all the way to 80.
7	MR. EAKELEY: So moved.
8	MS. MERCADO: I've got an
9	CHAIR SMEGAL: You have an amendment?
10	(No response.)
11	CHAIR SMEGAL: Let's have a second. Do you want to
12	second? Maria Luisa, please second.
13	MS. MERCADO: Oh, I second.
14	CHAIR SMEGAL: Oh, thank you. While you're looking

16	MS. MERCADO: Yes, I'm not quite on page 78, the
17	first full paragraph, third line. I think that we meant to
18	say morale, rather than moral. I don't want anybody to think

1 MR. McCALPIN: You have to add either the "s" or 2 the "e," I think.

3 CHAIR SMEGAL: All right, what else? 4 MS. MERCADO: And then somewhere, the -- I don't know whether it would be actually the -- I guess it must have 5 б been on -- when they were talking about doing additional staff people that we talked about making sure that we had 7 folks that were experienced. 8 9 Yes, it's the -- let me see, the paragraph that starts with, "Chairman Smegal and Mr. McKay." 10 11 CHAIR SMEGAL: "Discuss the results panel?" You're 12 talking about the third paragraph on page 78? 13 MS. MERCADO: Right. Yes, I thought we discussed 14 that -- at least for a few minutes, anyway -- the discussion 15 about that additional staff being people who have experience 16 with legal services as the compliance and enforcement 17 staffing it, I think we discussed it. 18 I mean, I don't know how you would incorporate it 19 in it, but I think that that was important, so that we're just not necessarily hiring consultants or people in that 20

field that don't have the experience or expertise of legal

CONDRAY: Yes, I do. 9 CHAIR SMEGAL: Okay, all right. Anything else? All right, there's one little change on page 79, under 10 11 "vote," the meeting -- second sentence, "The meeting 12 adjourned, "to" open session, rather than "in," because the meeting adjourned "in" open session a little later, at 11:45, 13 14 I think. 15 We're just warming up here, aren't MR. EAKELEY: 16 we? 17 MS. MERCADO: Darn. See, I thought I had it by the 18 19 MR.
