SUBJECT: QUARTERLY EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT
INTERFACES

This letter is to inform local child support agencies that the Employment Development Department (EDD) recently agreed to perform interface reconciliation activities with the Department of Child Support Services' (DCSS) Integrated Data Base (IDB) System on a quarterly basis. The first reconciliation was run on April 10, 2001.

The process consists of EDD providing a full reconciliation file to DCSS for processing against the IDB application. DCSS will then apply the reconciliation update transactions to IDB and provide EDD with update transactions. In the short run, local child support agencies should expect a larger than normal EDD Weekly Name Mismatch Report (CSD2350-A) when DCSS runs the quarterly reconciliation.

The reconciliation process will allow both agencies to reconcile cases that were submitted for the unemployment insurance benefit (UIB) and disability insurance benefit (DIB) intercept program and will eventually decrease the number of name mismatches and reject files.
