SUBJECT: ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES IN INTERNATIONAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT

The Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) has reorganized the functions of the United States Authority for International Child Support Enforcement with the intent of improving customer service to the public and state and local partners. The Division of Consumer Services (DCS) is the office's point of contact with the public and state agencies on case-specific inquiries. DCS is responsible for handling case-specific inquiries on international cases. J. Richard Sternowski is the exclusive point of contact and can be reached for this purpose at ocseinternational@acf.hhs.gov.

DCS has also added to their homepage at <http://www.acf.hhs.gov/programs/cse/>, an OCSE 'International Resources' link which accesses: OCSE international policy issuances; legal references; the Department of State child support website; links to specific child support information; federal agreements; policies; procedures; forms and the Intergovernmental Referral Guide.

The Division of Policy (DP) within the OCSE is led by Lily Matheson and is responsible for negotiating bilateral agreements with the State Department, developing and issuing policy guidance to states and foreign reciprocating countries, and resolving policy questions. DP staff are responsible for any questions related to negotiation efforts, legislation and policy guidance in the international child support arena. OCSE also works in close partnership with the Department of State on international child support matters. Mary Helen Carlson at carlsonmh@state.gov is responsible for the negotiation of bilateral and multilateral child support agreements.
