

1. Southbound on I-29 (From Sioux City, IA)

Take I-29 south to I-480 West. Exit at Dodge Street/30th Street (Exit 2B). Turn Right (North) on 30th Street. Go 1 ½ blocks and turn right on California.

2. Northbound on I-29 (From Kansas City, MO)

Take I-29 North to I-480 West. Exit at Dodge Street/30th Street (Exit 2B). Turn Right (North) on 30th Street. Go 1 ½ blocks and turn right on California.

3. Westbound on I-80 (From Des Moines, IA)

Take I-80 West to I-680 to I-29 South, then to I-480 West. Exit at Dodge Street/30th Street. Turn right (North) on 30th Street. Go 1 ½ blocks and turn right on California.

4. Eastbound on I-80 (From Lincoln, NE)

Take I-80 East to I-480 North. Exit at Dodge Street Exit. Go 3 blocks North until you are at Dodge Street. Go West approximately 3 blocks, turn right onto 30th Street (Amoco station on right). Go through the first set of stop lights and then turn right on California Street.

Parking

Parking is available in the front of the main BTNRH entrance. If this lot is full, when exiting the lot, turn left on Cass Street. Parking is available in the BTNRH Patient/Visitors lot ½ blocks, then left. Additional parking facilities are available in the St. Joseph Hospital Patient/Visitor Parking lots which are accessible by remaining on 30th Street to a point just beyond California Street in the far right lane.
