The Memorial Grove Committee has developed preliminary plans for the annual Memorial Grove field day event scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. at the Monument Fire Center, west of Monument, Colorado.

This year's event will include placement of the newest plaque and planting a tree in memory of all Region 2 employees who passed away during 2008. Part of the day will be devoted to improving and maintaining the site and sharing a potluck meal with family members, retirees, and fellow employees.

Nearly 850 deceased Region 2 employees have been honored by having their names engraved on plaques at Memorial Grove. To be recognized, the person had to have been a current employee or must have retired from Forest Service employment in Region 2. The 2008 list of honorees is not fully compiled; we need your help in completing the list.

If you are aware of anyone who passed away in 2008 who should be recognized and is not on the list included in this letter, please let us know no later than April 10. As soon as the list is completed, we will have the year 2008 plaque prepared for the ceremony. For any names you submit, please provide as much information as possible about their Forest Service history and family addresses so that we can recognize their work and invite their family members to attend the event.

If you are aware of anyone who passed away before 2008 and has not been inducted, we would like their names and family contact information so they can be part of the "Not Forgotten Ceremony" at this year's ceremony.
