On request of the U.S. Marshal Service, it is hereby


ORDERED THAT:

1. Roger Tanner, previously convicted of unlawful possession of a weapon in Case No. 3:89cr766 and communicating a threat through interstate commerce [such threat having been made against a federal judicial officer] in Case No. 3:01cr702, shall not be permitted to enter any U.S. Courthouse in the Northern District of Ohio, including, without limitation, courthouses in which the U.S. Bankruptcy Court is located, unless accompanied at all times by a Deputy U.S. Marshal or Court Security Officer.
2. While on the premises of any U.S. Courthouse in this District, Mr. Tanner shall comply with all reasonable requests and/or commands of the U.S. Marshal Service, including an instruction to leave the building in the event his presence causes, or appears reasonably likely to cause disruption in the business of the courts or other disturbance.
3. The U.S. Marshal Service shall cause a copy of this Order to be served on Mr. Tanner when he next enters a U.S. Courthouse within this District.

Noncompliance with this Order shall constitute a contempt of Court, and shall subject the contemnor to all appropriate and lawfully permissible sanctions and punishment.
