CREATION OF THE DOCKET FOR JUDGE SARA E. LIOI)	ORDER NO. 2007-03

At the regular meeting of the judges conducted on October 10, 2006 the Court approved the method for creating a docket for newly appointed Judge Sara E. Lioi. In order to create this docket, the Court agreed to abide by the following "premises":

- (1) The February 28, 2007 pending civil dockets will be utilized in arriving at the "average docket".
- (2) The following judges shall participate in the creation of the dockets prompted by the arrival of Judge Lioi:

Hon. Kathleen M. O'Malley

Hon. Peter C. Economus

Hon. Donald C. Nugent

Hon. Patricia A. Gaughan

Hon, James S. Gwin

Hon. Dan Aaron Polster

Hon. Christopher A. Boyko

Hon. Sara E. Lioi

(3) The average docket will be determined by dividing the pending civil inventory by 10, the number of participating judges.

- (4) No case may be transferred to Judge Lioi which has previously been transferred twice before. No judge may transfer a case more than two-years old. Should a judge have insufficient cases to transfer within a category, then waivers will be generated.
- (5) The selection and distribution of cases shall apply to the following categories of cases. The percentages are representative of the pending caseload in the Eastern Division, as of the close of February 28, 2007.

- (6) The Clerk's Office will provide a breakdown of the number of cases by category a judge may transfer or waive to Judge Lioi, as well as an actual case listing of cases that may be transferred.
- (7) The transferor judge will identify those cases by category to be transferred and shall provide their case listing of transferred cases by category to the Clerk within one week of the date of this order.
- (8) In the event Judge Lioi is disqualified from hearing a case which was transferred to her pursuant to this order, that case shall be returned to the transferor judge. The transferor judge will then be permitted to designate for transfer another case in the same category.
- (9) The prior magistrate judge assignments to cases transferred under this protocol will remain unchanged.
- (10) For the convenience of the parties, judges are asked, all other things being equal, to give consideration to transferring "Akron" based cases.

(11) Judge Lioi will be placed on the civil draw upon entrance on duty and on the criminal draw on 30 days after the date of entrance on duty.
