The purpose of this letter is to inform all local child support agencies (LCSAs) that the California Child Support Automation Systems (CCSAS) Guideline Calculator will be available for use August 28, 2006, with CCSAS Version 1.4 and will become the single statewide solution required for use by all LCSAs.

Once the CCSAS Guideline Calculator is available, LCSA staff should no longer use DissoMaster or any other stand alone calculator. The federal certification requirements specify that the CCSAS guideline calculator is the only calculator that should be used.

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) will provide training on the use of the CCSAS Guideline Calculator. Training sessions are scheduled for August 18th and 25th, 2006. These sessions will be available by videoconference and web-cast, with video tapes of the training available at a later date.
