This is in reference to your submission dated March 28, 2000, concerning Clavamox Tablets (amoxicillin, clavulanic acid ), NADA 055-099 and Clavamox Drops, NADA 055-101.

This submission includes five (5) pieces of Promotional Labeling, namely the Dental Client Education Brochure, coded CLA9902, Dental Client Poster, coded CLA9903, Dental Client Educational Dental Chart and Marker, coded CLA010001, Dental Client Placard, coded CLA010002, and Dental Client Notepad, coded CLA 010003. We have the following comments and requests:

The Dental Client Education Brochure (coded CLA9902) is considered labeling which fails to provide full prescribing information, in other words, the reproduction of the package insert as required under 21 CFR 201.105(d)(1).
