<u>Staff Issues Updated Safety Evaluation Report with Open Items Related to the Oyster Creek</u> Generating Station License Renewal Application

On October 3, 2006, the staff met with the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) License Renewal Subcommittee to discuss the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) with Open Items related to the Oyster Creek Generating Station license renewal application. Because of the drywell corrosion issue associated with Oyster Creek, the ACRS requested a second subcommittee meeting for January 18, 2007. A necessary report from Sandia National Laboratories with the final results of the confirmatory analysis has not been completed. Sandia National Laboratories staff issued a final report concerning the integrity of the Oyster Creek drywell on January 12, 2007. In order to obtain comments from the ACRS Subcommittee and to discuss publicly available information, the staff modified and issued the SER with Open Items for Oyster Creek, Revision 1, on December 29, 2006. Following the ACRS Subcommittee meeting, the staff plans to issue the final Oyster Creek SER, which will include information from the Sandia Report.

<u>Publication of "Multi-Agency Radiation Survey and Assessment of Materials and Equipment Manual (MARSAME)," (NUREG-1575, Supplement 1)</u>

During the week of January 1, 2007, the subject report was made available for public review and comment for a period of 90 days. MARSAME provides technically defensible processes and methods for the measurement of radioactivity associated with materials and equipment, and is compatible with the Multi-Agency Radiation Survey and Site Investigation Manual (MARSSIM). The author agencies are the NRC, the Department of Defense, the Department of Energy, and the Environmental Protection Agency.

Rule Change to Move Libya from Embargoed to Restricted Destinations List

On December 29, 2006, the Acting Executive Director for Operations signed a final rule moving Libya from the NRC's embargoed destinations list in 10 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 110.28 to NRC's restricted destinations list in 10 CFR 110.29. This action was taken in response to the Executive Branch rescission of Libya's designation as a State Sponsor of Terrorism and is necessary to align NRC's export/import regulations with current U.S. Government law and policy on Libya. This rule change will permit the use of general licenses in Part 110 for exports to Libya. The rule is expected to be published in the Federal Register shortly.
