Full-time Law Enforcement Officers by Geographic Region and Division by Population Group, Number and Rate per 1,000 Inhabitants, 2006

- In the U.S. in 2006, the average number of full-time law enforcement officers in cities was 2.3 per 1,000 inhabitants.
- Within cities in the Northeast, the rate of full-time law enforcement officers per 1,000 inhabitants was 2.7.
- The rate of full-time law enforcement officers per 1,000 was 2.6 within cities in the South.
- Within cities in the Midwest, the rate of full-time law enforcement officers per 1,000 was 2.2.
- The rate of full-time law enforcement officers per 1,000 inhabitants was 1.7 within cities in the West.
