Arrests, Nonmetropolitan Counties, by Race, 2007

- In nonmetropolitan counties in 2007, most arrestees (82.1 percent) were white.
 Black persons accounted for 14.4 percent of all arrestees, and the remainder of arrestees were of other races.
- Of the individuals arrested in nonmetropolitan counties for violent crimes,
 73.8 percent were white. Of those arrested for property crimes, 82.2 percent were white.
- More than 81 percent (81.1) of the juveniles (persons under the age of 18) arrested in the Nation's nonmetropolitan counties in 2007 were white.
- In 2007, white persons under the age of 18 accounted for 67.7 percent of violent crime arrestees and 83.5 percent of property crime arrestees in nonmetropolitan counties.
- More than half (52.9 percent) of juveniles arrested for robbery in nonmetropolitan counties were black.
