Arrests, Nonmetropolitan Counties, by Sex, 2007

- In 2007 in the Nation's nonmetropolitan counties, most (77.0 percent) of the 762,782 arrestees were males.
- Males accounted for 83.7 percent of all persons arrested for violent crimes and for 77.9 percent of all persons arrested for property crimes in nonmetropolitan counties.
- In nonmetropolitan counties, males were most often arrested for driving under the influence (111,183) and drug abuse violations (71,539); females were most often arrested for driving under the influence (26,934) and drug abuse violations (18,939).
