HELPFUL √ CHECKLIST



- Programs are scheduled for the months of September, October and November then again in March, April and May.
- You must submit a fee waiver request, on school letterhead, to the superintendent of Canaveral National Seashore, at least two weeks prior to your field trip.
- Group size is limited to 70 students (usually two classes). If you have more than 2 classes, we may need to schedule additional days.
- Students are asked to be in the park no later than 10:00 a.m. Programs last 2 hours. If you are late this will take away from your program time because we still must end at 12:00 p.m.
- Please arrive ready to go in the water. (Shoes, clothes, sunscreen etc.) (This applies to lagoon programs only).
- Park Rangers ask that everyone wear a name tag.
- Please advise of cancellation as soon as possible so that we may book another group.
- If you are going to be late please call (386) 428-3384 ext.18, and notify Ranger Alonda McCarty or Ranger Laura Henning.
- Lightning or other extreme weather conditions may cause a program to be cancelled.
- All food must remain on the bus until after the program.
- The bus must be parked and shut off for the duration of the program.
