

Open-File Report 01-401

Each year, the U.S. Forest Service requests a number of individual reports on locatable mineral resources for specific land parcels considered for exchange. This report is a compilation of reports provided in fiscal years 2000 and 2001. Instead of being arranged chronologically by report date, this data release arranges the reports by State and National Forest.

You are viewing the instructions in 1stREADME.pdf. This report is comprised of 77 files. The text for 16 locatable mineral reports and one revision is in files named locminXX.pdf. Figures (termed “attachments” in the reports) are numbered Fig1 through Fig54. Some figures cover multiple pages; these are numbered and followed by a lower case letter. The master file that ties the 17 reports and 58 figures together is OF01-401. It contains a table of contents, list of figures, and explanatory text.

To use this report, open the file OF01_401.pdf. Bookmarks are provided along the left side of the screen to navigate to individual reports and their attachments. Click on the bookmarked name of the report to go to the report. From the individual report, click on the bookmarked name of the Attachment to view the figures. To return to the text of the report, click on the bookmark. To return to the master file, OF01-401, click on the bookmark “contents” (returning you to the title page) and scroll to the next page to see the contents, or if you know the name of the report you wish to view, click on the bookmark. Hot links from the “contents” directly to the individual text files are an alternate way to navigate: click on the blue report number (locminXX) to go directly to the report without using the bookmarks. Return to the “contents” using the bookmarks.
