Call to Order: CAPT Raelene Skerda (<u>rskerda@bop.gov</u>)

- CAPT Skerda called the meeting to order and the last meeting minutes were accepted with no additional edits.
- The meeting began with a presentation:

Pharmacy School Pont of Contact Program: CDR Beth Fritsch

- There are currently 92 schools of pharmacy with 150 volunteers representing each of the schools.
- The mission of the program is to increase the awareness of PHS to students. Points of contact are responsible for setting up promotion ceremonies and presenting the student awards (Excellence in Public Health Pharmacy).
- A survey was done among the POCs through a data website to gather information on involvement at each of the schools. The proposal is to use this as a tool to gather information and track the visits of the POCs.
- The Point of Contact program has been a success for the pharmacy category, and other categories are adopting the program.

 - Membership:

 - The pharmacy category has been noted as the strongest category within ARP with the highest numbers of ARPs.

 - <u>Readiness (LCDR Strong)</u>: The pharmacy category stands at 54% basic readiness qualified. There is currently a problem with the database, and this number may not be an accurate reflection.
 - <u>COA Category Day(CDR Potter)</u>: The pharmacy category day agenda has been set.
 - <u>Civilian Service</u>: Nothing to report.
- <u>Communication</u>→ CDR Sam Foster (<u>Samuel.foster@ihs.gov</u>) & LCDR Nita Sood (<u>Nsood@cms.hhs.gov</u>)
 - The PLANT workgroup identified the obsolete profiles. The group is looking to add two new profiles by the end of March. The goal is to create one new profile each month.
 - The HHS web management team informed the PAC of a new OMB regulation published December 2004 that federal sites cannot move to a private server. Other options may be to use the IHS or NIH server.

New Business

- A question was raised whether the board certification pay for BS pharmacists has been clarified. CAPT Skerda stated that the language was looked at by RADM Walling and he is currently working on the issue.
- The website for the OFRD modules has changed.
- A comment was raised that it is difficult to comply with deployments since the home site receives no funding to backfill. This makes it difficult to receive local support within your agency for PHS deployments.
