Call to Order: LCDR Laura Pincock (laura.pincock@fda.hhs.gov)

LCDR Pincock called the May 2006 Pharmacy Professional Advisory Committee (PharmPAC) meeting to order. Minutes from the previous meeting were accepted with few edits: (WACS photo upload capability note was deleted per CDR Foster; other edit suggestions received via e-mail).

CPO Comments: RADM Robert Pittman

- COA Conference a success; approximately 1200 registered officers participated
- ♦ Transformation
 - o Awaiting final recommendation from the Secretary
 - No issues are expected to affect many areas of the policy; consensus was to move forward with Transformation initiatives
- Public Affairs Campaign for the PHS Corps
 - Expect information over the next few months
 - Materials and brochures are being reviewed by focus groups consisting of PHS physicians, nurses, dentists, and pharmacists
- Office of Force Readiness and Deployment (OFRD)
 - Officers need to sign up for Teams
 - o Notifications of Tier / Team assignments will be will be sent around mid June
 - Deployment: Officers on medical leave (even short term) need to apply for a deployment waiver from the Medical Affairs Branch, otherwise the officer is assumed deployable
- CPO Board activity
 - Transformation PAC to provide assistance to Surgeon General (SG) and Assistant Secretary for Health (ASH) in transformation policy implementation; more information will be provided in the near future
- Office of Commissioned Corps Operations (OCCO)
 - 2001 laws state that Child Care National Check with Inquiries (CNACI) is good for only 15 years and must be renewed upon expiration; details are forthcoming
- Commissioned Officers' Effectiveness Report (COER)
 - Reporting period ends September 30th to coincide with Transformation
 - 117 officers from all categories still do not have completed COERS on file; 2/3 have not been initiated by the officer
 - Contact agency liaison for assistance
- Promotion
 - $\circ~$ Board recommendations completed; promotions are expected to be announced between June $15^{th}~$ and July $1^{st}~$
 - Eligibility is noted to be generous this year as cutoff percentages have fluctuated downward
 - Three and Freeze Assistant Secretary for Health (ASH) decided not to postpone the policy as recommended by the PAC, but rather chose to have a task force search for an optimal implementation plan

 - Basic Officer Training Course (BOTC) will be a two-week course beginning January 2007
