CDR Sood called the June 2007 Pharmacist Professional Advisory Committee (PharmPAC) meeting to order.

Minutes from the May 3, 2007 PharmPAC meeting were accepted as amended.

#### **CPO Comments: RADM Robert Pittman**

- 2007 PHS Scientific and Training Symposium
  - o 800+ officers in attendance with over 100 pharmacists at the meeting
- USS Peleliu
  - o CAPT Kathleen Downs named Officer in Charge
- Promotion Boards
  - o 434 possible pharmacy promotions
  - o Promotion rates different for categories based on number of billets
  - Suggestions for promotion
    - Prepare and submit to eOPF a current CV
    - Keep summary page to one page
    - Provide documentation of Achievement of advanced degree
- Retention
  - o Pharmacy has a good retention rate
  - 97% retention rate, 94% with retirement
  - o Pharmacy category retirement eligibility
    - 53% of pharmacy officers have less than 10 years of service
    - 36% have between 10-20 years of service
    - 11% are eligible for retirement today
  - o Pharmacy officers separate within the first 4 years

- Awards
  - Awards take forever
  - Trying to speed up the process
    - New awards CCIS
      - Has specific timelines (3 weeks) to process awards and if the timeline is not met then the award moves to the next higher level
      - Taking approval for awards to a lower levels
    - PharmPAC will still be able to initiate the awards process
- Immunization training
  - o Training held at COA meeting
  - O Looking for additional funding for future training
  - Contact PAC if interested in training
- Met with the emergency coordinators for the 8 states in Region 4
  - Reviewed hurricane preparedness
  - O June 1<sup>st</sup> is start of the Hurricane season
- OFRD
  - o Currently officers get an e-mail to respond if available for deployment
  - Changing the process in the coming months to respond to the e-mail if the officer is not available
- New Surgeon General Nominee
  - o Dr. James W. Holsinger, Jr.
- Assimilation
  - o 2006 assimilation list approved by the Senate in April 2007
  - o 2007 group is working its way through the system
  - o The 2800 ceiling is expected to be met with the 2007 group
  - Those who are interested in the Regular Corps should apply as soon as they are eligible
  - o Permanent promotion rate will be affected by the 2800 ceiling
- Review of billets
  - o New electronic billets for all officers as a part of transformation
  - Beta-testing new billet formats
  - o Billets will not be looked at for 08 promotion cycle
  - o Billets are preset for lowest level possible
  - o Clinical billets will be out in the next year
  - o Non-clinical billets will take longer and will be available later
