Courses may also be taken individually, for those who are not interested in pursuing the Certificate but would like training in specific areas. Current course offerings include: Grantwriting, Fundraising, Strategic Planning, Board Development, Financial Management, Human Resource Management, Program Planning and Evaluation, Ethics and Legal Issues, Volunteer Management and Public Policy and Advocacy.

As of now, registration is open for the second section of Introduction to Fundraising (May 18 to June 26) and Human Resource Management, the first, new ten-week, two-credit course (June 1 to August 7). Five new two-credit courses will be offered beginning this August, in addition to the five one-credit courses we have been offering. All of next academic year's courses will be open for registration by the beginning of June. Please check the Continuing Ed website for registration information - we do not have an exact date yet.

The certificate will require twelve course credits and a 350-hour, 4-credit internship. ALL coursework for the Certificate must be taken for graded credit
