California's landmark global warming legislation, AB 32, requires that the state's greenhouse gas emissions be reduced to 1990 levels by 2020. What effect will reducing greenhouse gases have on reducing criteria and toxic pollutants? Can we prioritize control efforts to maximize synergies and avoid negative impacts?

The AQMD is hosting this one-day forum at which a panel of experts will discuss the potential benefits and conflicting effects of efforts to control greenhouse gas and other pollutant emissions. There will be a series of presentations by the panelists, followed by a roundtable discussion – first among the panelists and then open to the audience.
