Bill Quinn is the Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of the California Council for Environmental and Economic Balance – a coalition of California business, labor and public policy leaders that collaborates to advance strategies for a sound economy and a healthy environment. CCEEB was created over a quarter of a century ago by the late Governor Edmund G. “Pat” Brown to advance new ideas to effectively address the challenges facing California. CCEEB focuses its efforts on issues such as climate change, air quality, water quality and hazardous waste management.

Mr. Quinn oversees policy leadership, program oversight, membership development and member relations, and represents the Council in numerous public forums. Mr. Quinn also manages CCEEB’s South Coast Air Project and its Bay Area Partnership. These projects explore creative solutions to regional air quality problems, and work closely with district regulators and local communities.

Prior to joining CCEEB in 1995, Mr. Quinn held environmental management positions for over 15 years in the energy and utility industries. He worked closely with key stakeholders in negotiating many of California’s principal environmental statutes.
