SUBJECT: Results of Certification Review Board

The Project Management Career Development Program (PMCDP) Certification Review Board (CRB) convened on January 19, 2007, to consider PMCDP certification for persons with IT project management experience.

The CRB has discussed the issue of using Information Technology (IT) project management experience to qualify for PMCDP certification. The CRB has decided that it will not accept a certification application based on IT experience because:

- The PMCDP CRB responsibility is to review and certify Federal Project Director's in support of the Department's construction, experimental equipment, environmental management, and capital assets.
- The IT project manager certification program managed by the Office of Chief Information Officer (CIO) is responsible for the review and certification for IT projects.

Based upon the foregoing CRB policy decision, persons with IT experience pursuing certification should be referred to the CIO.
