dates that would exceed the 60 day period prescribed
in Commission regulations.

1. <u>Page 1, Line 15</u>: Insert the following sentence, "The Commission seeks comments on the policy under consideration, and on any other circumstances arising out of the events of September 11 that need to be addressed."

- 2. Page 1, Lines 16 and 17: Amend the sentence to read, "Comments must be submitted on or before November 14, 2001."
- 3. Page 4, at the end of Line 6: Insert a new sentence to read: "Alternatively, the Commission would not pursue an untimely party committee transfer made to cover the nonfederal share of an allocable expense paid between August 27, 2001 and December 31, 2001, if the transfer is made no later than March 1, 2002, and is fully disclosed on the party committee's applicable report."
- 4. Page 4, Line 7: Delete the words, "this proposed policy" and substitute the words "the policy that is under consideration" in lieu thereof.
 - a. Also, amend similar language throughout the draft to conform to this amendment.
- 5. <u>Page 4. Line 8:</u> Insert the following language at the end of the sentence after the word "duration":

"or any other circumstances arising out of the attacks of September 11 that should be addressed."
