#### II. DRAFT ADVISORY OPINION 2003-25

Weinzapfel for Mayor Committee, by counsel, Neil P. Reiff

Vice Chairman Smith, now presiding, stated

Chair Weintraub had recused herself with respect to the above-subject matter and would not be present during the discussion.

The Vice Chairman recognized Mr. Richard Ewell of the General Counsel's Office who presented draft Advisory Opinion 2003-25 concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), and Commission regulations to advertisements to be run by the Weinzapfel Committee that will feature U.S. Senator Evan Bayh's endorsement of Mr. Weinzapfel for Mayor of Evansville, Indiana.

### II. <u>DRAFT ADVISORY OPINION 2003-25</u> (continued)

Chair Weintraub recognized Commissioner Toner who offered the following proposed amendments to the draft:

- 1. Page 4, Footnote 3 amended to
  read:
  - "Congress did not define the phrase 'promotes, supports, attacks, or opposes.'"
- 2. <u>Page 6,</u> delete the sentence which begins on <u>Line 7 and</u> ends on Line 12.
- 3. Page 6 at the end of Line 22 insert the following sentence:

"Based on the facts you have presented, the 'Committed' advertisement falls into this category; the advertisement endorses the candidacy of Mr. Weinzapfel for Mayor of Evansville, not Senator Bayh for the U.S. Senate, and does not support, attack, promote or oppose any Federal candidate."

- 4. Delete the text which begins on Page 6, Line 23, through Page 7, Line 14.
- Furthermore" at the beginning of the sentence and change the word "would" to "does"; move the sentence to the end of the paragraph on Page 6, after the new sentence on Line 22 above.
- 6. Page 7, delete the text beginning with the sentence on Line 17 through Line 24.
- 7. Page 10, Lines 16 and 17, delete the words "well before the sixty day period" and insert the words "many months" in lieu thereof.

Following discussion, Vice Chairman Smith recognized Commissioner Toner, who

MOVED to approve draft Advisory Opinion 2003-25, as submitted in Agenda Document No. 03-75, subject to the amendments noted above.
