A discussion followed.

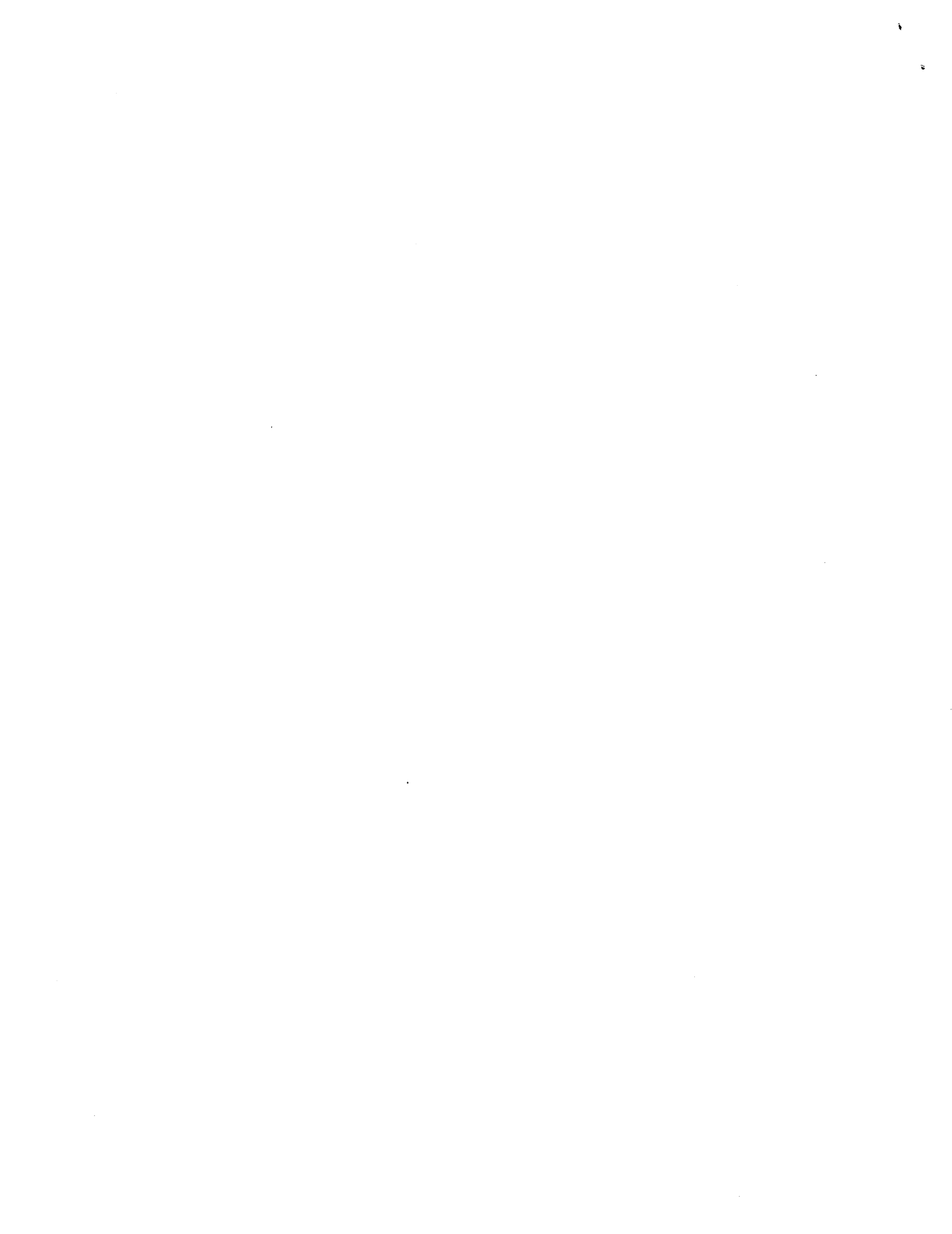
The Chairman recognized Commissioner Weintraub, who

The motion carried on the vote of 6-0.

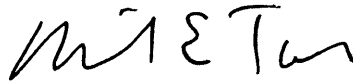
IV. ROUTINE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS
