What is the issue: Random Inspection when Carrying Food

Why do we need this: Prevention of damage to x-ray equipment

Who is impacted: Visitors and persons selected for random

inspection

What does the HSO need to do: Distribute to your organizational personnel

The requirement that food items be <u>visually inspected</u> by the Protective Force and not passed through the X-ray machines is not for the purpose of preventing irradiation of the food. It is to prevent damage to the X-ray equipment that could be caused by food spillage. If you are carrying food or any liquid that could spill and are selected for random inspection, please hand carry your items through the detector. Do not place food items on the conveyor belt. If requested by the Protective Force Officer, please open the container(s) for visual inspection.
