    - (i) Population of 12,000 or less; and
    - (ii) Median household income of the population to be served by the proposed facility is below the higher of the poverty line or 70 percent of the State nonmetropolitan median household income.
  - (c) 35 percent when the proposed project is located in a rural community having a:
    - (i) Population of 20,000 or less; and
    - (ii) Median household income of the population to be served by the proposed facility is below the higher of the poverty line or 80 percent of the State nonmetropolitan median household income.
  - (d) 15 percent when the proposed project is located in a rural community having a:
    - (i) Population of 50,000 or less; and
    - (ii) Median household income of the population to be served by the proposed facility is below the higher of the poverty line or 90 percent of the State nonmetropolitan median household income.
