DEMOCRATS CLAIM DISCLOSING TRAVEL IS A SAFETY RISK—EXCEPT WHEN THEY DO IT

Democrats falsely claim that the whereabouts of congressional delegations to high-risk zones are not discussed until after they return to the United States – but apparently their own senior members did not get the message.

"Generally speaking, we encourage the members to hold off on any communication until they are wheels down at Andrews Air Force Base," said Courtney Littig, an Intelligence Committee spokeswoman. Disclosing the movements of a high-profile delegation, she said, not only put at risk the safety of the members but also the military escorts who accompany them.
