




- Other Factors Associated with a High Potential for Violence


# INDIVIDUAL CHARACTERISTICS

Loner / Withdrawn	Substance Abuse
Fascination with Violent Music, Games, Movies	Views world as hostile
Obsession with Weapons	Views world as threatening
Poor Interpersonal Skills	Low Frustration Tolerance
Poor Employment Hx	Impatient
Suspicious of Others	Financial Stress
Problem with Authority Figures	Blames Others for Problems
Frequent Mood Swings	Shunned by Co-workers

- Not all mentally ill individuals are violent.




#### REMEMBER!


