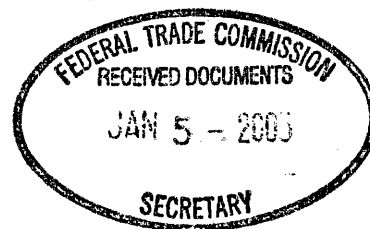





**NON-PARTY ADVOCATE HEALTH CARE'S  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING ITS  
IN CAMERA MOTION FOR TREATMENT OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS**

Advocate Health Care ("Advocate") which is not a party to the above-captioned action, respectfully requests that this Court grant it an extension of time in which to file its motion for in camera treatment of certain documents that respondents Evanston Northwestern Healthcare Corporation and ENH Medical Group, Inc. (collectively "Respondents") have designated for introduction into evidence in the administrative trial in this matter, and in support thereof, states as follows:

1. Motions for in camera treatment of documents in this matter were due on January 4, 2005 before 5:00 p.m.
2. Advocate filed an in camera motion with the Office of the Secretary of the FTC on January 4, 2005. However, the motion was filed-stamped after 5:00 p.m. and before 6:00 p.m.
3. There is no prejudice to any of the parties to this action by the filing of Advocate's in camera motion after 5:00 p.m. on January 4, 2005.

4. There is no prejudice to any of the parties to this action by granting an extension of time to Advocate for filing its in camera motion after 5:00 p.m. on January 4, 2005.

5. The purpose of this motion is not to delay these proceedings or to prejudice any of the parties to these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Advocate Health Care respectfully requests that this Court enter an order granting Advocate a one day extension of time in which to file its motion for in camera treatment of certain documents or until January 5, 2005.

**PROPOSED ORDER**

On January 5, 2005, Non-Party Advocate Health Care (“Advocate”) filed a motion for extension of time in which to file its motion for in camera treatment of confidential business information contained in certain documents that have been identified by respondents Evanston Northwestern Healthcare Corporation and ENH Medical Group, Inc. (collectively “Respondents”) as potential evidentiary exhibits.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Advocate’s motion for extension of time in which to file its motion for in camera treatment of these documents is GRANTED. Advocate is granted until January 5, 2005 to file its motion for in camera treatment of documents.
