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PREFACE

Publications by scientists of the Northeast Fisheries Center for 1984 are listed on the following pages. For the purposes of this listing, "publications" refers to formally published papers, which have received anonymous peer review, or have been released in NOAA-administered publications.

Scientists of the Northeast Fisheries Center also produce internally reviewed papers as Woods Hole Laboratory Reference Documents, Sandy Hook Laboratory Reports, International Council for the Exploration of the Seas (ICES) C.M. Documents, Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Organization (NAFO) Scientific Council Research (SCR) Documents, contract reports, book reviews and abstracts. These less formal papers, which are categorized as "grey literature," are an important part of the Center's published output.

Previous to 1984, publications by scientists of the Northeast Fisheries Center were listed in the Collected Reprints of the Northeast Fisheries Center. This listing of publications, compiled in 1985, is being released as a Woods Hole Laboratory Reference Document to document and preserve the formal publication record of the Northeast Fisheries Center scientists for the year 1984.
