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Introduction

The following bibliography consists of three sections: (1) anonymously peer-reviewed publications (“publications”); (2) transparently (not anonymously) peer-reviewed and non-peer reviewed publications (“reports”); and (3) abstracts for oral presentations and poster displays (“abstracts”). The bibliography covers works prepared by Northeast Fisheries Science Center (NEFSC) employees which have a 2005 publication date. Authors who were NEFSC employees at the time they composed their works, and/or who were NEFSC employees during all or part of 2005, are designated by capital letters.

Works which have a pre-2005 publication date but which were not released until 2005, or which have a 2005 publication date but had not been released at the time this list was published, have been included in this issue. They are noted by an asterisk (*) next to the publication date.

Editorial treatment of bibliographic entries is largely based on the Council of Science Editors style manual, seventh¹ edition. Special treatment includes the use of “pnk” and “np” throughout the “abstracts” section, to indicate the pagination is not known or the document is not paginated, respectively. A hyperlinked list of organization acronyms has been included on the Table of Contents page.
