TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's Application for a Temporary Restraining Order pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b). After due consideration of the record including the declaration of Tax Specialist Lucille Jessey, the Court finds that if a Temporary Restraining Order does not issue at this time, Ms. Buddhu is likely to continue to interfere with the administration of the internal revenue laws, causing irreparable harm to the public, the Internal Revenue Service and any customers whose returns she prepares.

Accordingly, the Plaintiff's Application for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED as modified below. This Court hereby orders that until May 16 at _10:00__ a.m., Defendant Sunita Buddhu shall be and is hereby precluded from:

¹ Although Defendant Sunita Buddhu has not opposed the plaintiff's Application for a Temporary Restraining Order, the Court notes that the Application was mailed to Ms. Buddhu on May 1, 2008. In Ruling on the Application, the Court has considered the arguments made by both defendants in opposition to the motion for a preliminary injunction.

- preparing federal income tax returns, amended federal income tax returns and other related documents and forms for others;
- 2. representing customers before the Internal Revenue Service;
- 3. advising, assisting, counseling, or instructing anyone about the preparation of a federal tax return; and
- 4. from promoting tax-fraud schemes.
