# FROM THE DESK OF MASSACHUSETTS SBA DIRECTOR, BOB NELSON

## SBA is on Sale!

It has been just about two months now since President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and I am pleased to report that here in Massachusetts we are seeing a marked increase in SBA loan activity. For the weeks ending 3/27/09 and 4/3/09 we saw 35 and 37 SBA guaranteed loans approved, respectively; by far the best SBA lending weeks we've had in Massachusetts for many, many months.



With the new incentives being offered to our lending partners in the form of an increased SBA guarantee of up to 90% of the loan and with the temporary elimination of many of the SBA fees on 7a and 504 loans, our products have become much more affordable for small businesses across the state, with much less risk exposure for our bank and credit union partners. These new tools coupled with the fact that interest rates are at historic lows means that if a small business is in the market for new equipment, owner occupied commercial real estate or working capital, there could not be a better time to be looking for an SBA loan.

The recent positive trends are making us cautiously optimistic that capital flow to small business is starting to increase. This increase in capital is so vital, as small businesses have been cash starved for many months now. Here at the Massachusetts SBA office, we are not taking this recent increase as an indication that we can slow down our efforts – much more work needs to be done and we are working it.

We still need our lending partners to help with increasing loans to start up ventures as this activity has fallen off due to the concerns and problems in the economy. It is important to remember that many individuals look to entrepreneurship as a way to provide for themselves and family when they experience a layoff and lack reasonable employment alternatives. Many very successful start ups have been realized during economic downturns. We also need our lenders to increase loans to our veteran and minority entrepreneurs and to make sure that everyone has equal access to our products. We also need to continue to get information about SBA changes out to the small business community so please help us to share the news.

More modifications and SBA program enhancements are in the works so please stay tuned but please call me directly if I can be of service or if you have any questions on programs for small business here in Massachusetts.
