Naval Station Mayport	Mayport Road Jacksonville, FL 32228	Controlled Industrial Facility	\$ 139,000,000	This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it is in accordance with Record of Decision of the Final EIS for the Proposed Homeporting of Additional Surface Ships At Naval Station Mayport, FL and is a top priority of the Navy. Scope includes a concrete/structural steel building required to support CVN propulsion plant maintenance functions. Includes heavily reinforced concrete floors with special foundation areas for equipment support; pile supported column footings; concrete shielding walls; HVAC, special high-efficiency ventilation systems; precast, pre-stressed hollow core concrete roof; bridge and jib cranes; utilities; fire protection; intrusion detection systems (IDS); security fencing; asphalt and concrete paving; elevator; industrial compressed air compressors and piping; waste storage building, container storage, water processing tank, specialized systems for processing solid and liquid waste.

Scope includes the removal of an estimated 5.2 million cubic yards of sediment from the turning basin, inner entrance channel and Jacksonville Harbor Bar Cut (outer channel) to the prescribed project depths(approximately 50 feet) and deposit the dredged material in the permitted open ocean disposal areas.</p>
