Know ye, That George M. Douch  
 a Private of Captain Leonard Aldrich's  
Company, (G.) 8th Regiment of Minnesota Infantry  
**VOLUNTEERS**, who was enrolled on the sixteenth day of August  
one thousand eight hundred and sixty two to serve three years or  
 during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States  
 this eleventh day of July, 1865, at Charlotte  
North Carolina by reason of ill instructions from blue flag July 1st 1865  
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said George M. Douch was born in Verway  
the State of Pennsylvania, is twenty eight years of age,  
five feet seven inches high, dark complexion, brown eyes,  
black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a farmer.

Given at Charlotte, N.C. this eleventh day of  
July, 1865.
