GAO Issues Government Auditing Standards

On February 1, the Comptroller General of the United States issued Government Auditing Standards, 2007 Revision, which supersedes the 2003 revisions except for those standards that establish quality control and peer review requirements. Based on feedback, the Government Accountability Office (GAO) has significantly redrafted and re-exposed those sections on quality control and peer review. Comments should be sent electronically to yellowbook@gao.gov no later than March 30. GAO plans to finalize these remaining sections and print the complete Government Auditing Standards, 2007 Revision, in late spring.

Survey on Auditor Training

On January 29, the Federal Audit Executive Council (FAEC) issued a survey to identify basic auditor training needs for the remainder of FY 2007 as well as to obtain your ideas for the best means of providing quality, cost-effective training in the future. DOD OIG will use the results of the "needs assessment" to determine the number of classes to be offered for the remainder of the year and produce a schedule as soon as possible.

Joint PCIE/CFO Council Task Force

On January 24, the PCIE and CFOC Financial Statement Task Force held its first meeting to address issues raised during the FY 2006 financial statement audit cycle. The task force will form two working groups. The first group will update the PCIE's Best Practice Guide: Coordinating the Preparation and Audit of Federal Financial Statements, which will be reissued jointly with the CFOC. The second group will identify ways to make financial reporting requirements more cost-beneficial.
